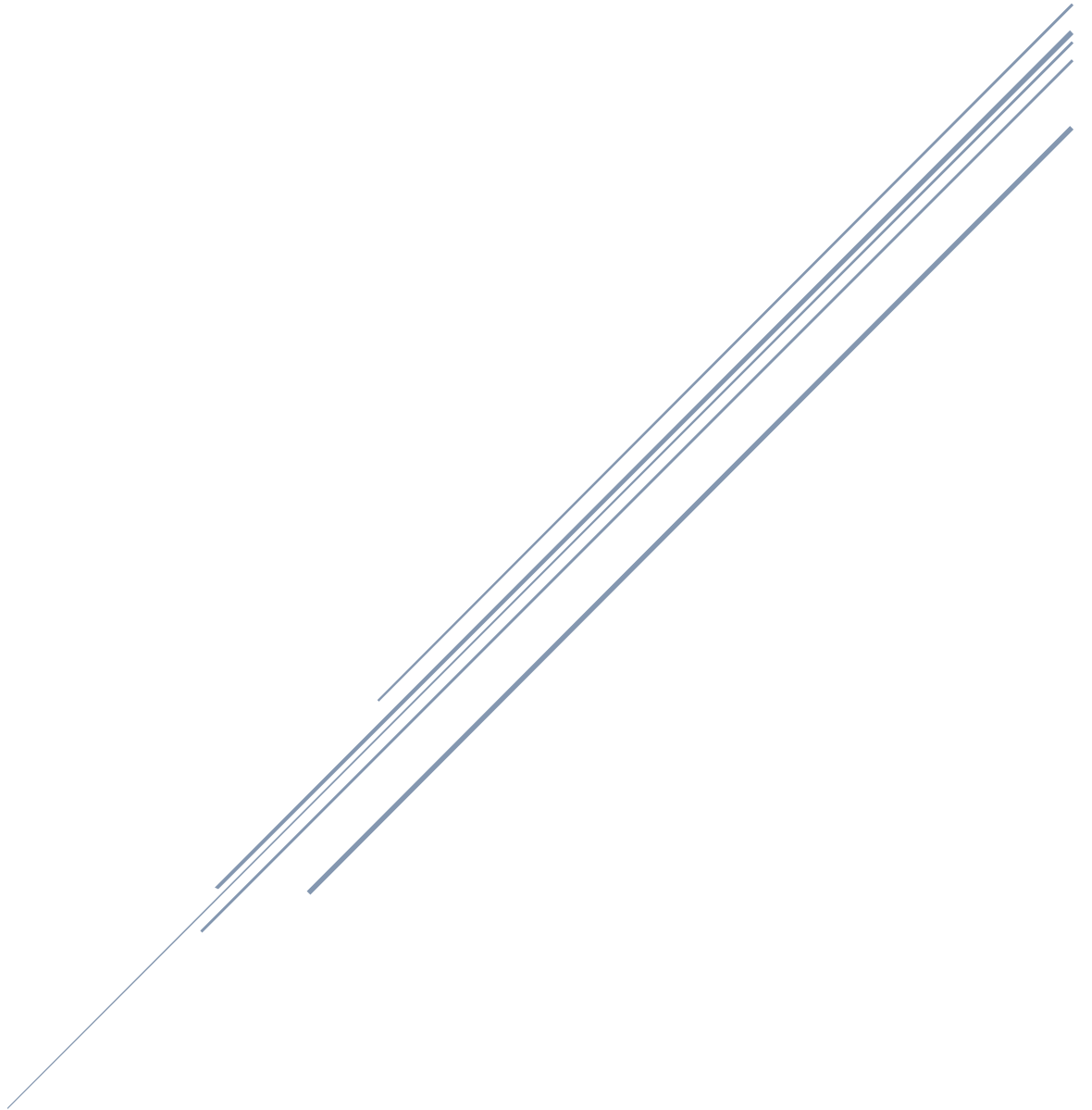

Miller County Ambulance District, is requesting proposals for a tax-exempt bank qualified lease-purchase for the financing of 2 new Type III ambulances for District use.

General Information and Terms:

Type of Lease:	Tax-Exempt Bank Qualified Lease-Purchase (Municipal Lease)
Equipment:	2 New Type III Ambulances
Amount Financed:	Approximately \$250,000.00
Lease Term:	48 Month
Payments:	Monthly payments, first payment estimated June 15 th , 2015
End of Term Options:	Transfer of Ownership to District
Other Terms	No Mileage Limits

The amount to be financed is an estimate, the exact amount will be determined at a later date. Lessor should calculate payments based on \$250,000.00. Lessor is responsible for providing lease documentation acceptable to the District.

Presentation of Proposals

All proposals shall indicate the interest rate and the monthly payment schedule structured as indicated above as well as all fees associated with the proposal.
